How To Register To Vote In Georgia When You are Homeless

Need to Know:

1. None of the 50 states requires that voters live in a traditional residence. On your voter registration forms, you can put a homeless shelter address, a street corner, a park bench – you can even attach a hand-drawn map, but **many states also require that you [provide a mailing address](#) where you can actually receive mail.** It can be a shelter, or a friend or relative's house, but it cannot be a P.O. box and it cannot be a park bench.
