### Applicant's will:

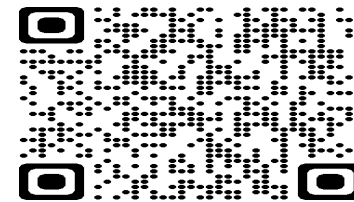
- ❖ Complete a Pre-Scavenger Hunt Questionnaire to discover how prepared they are for their transition.
- ❖ Identify their personal challenges and learn skills, behavior, and strategies to address them.
- ❖ Participate in a Virtual Scavenger Hunt by answering a series of open-ended questions to discover critical personnel, resources, and services on their campus or within their program that are available to help them make a successful transition.
